Positive Youth Culture Agreement

This agreement has been designed by young people for young people. It ensures that everyone can enjoy participating in our youth programs and events.

- 7. Help to maintain a healthy environment by not smoking or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- 8. Respect others privacy by not filming or taking photos without permission
- 9. Keep everyone safe by not bringing in dangerous items or stolen goods

- ✓ Information disclosed by young people to staff will be kept confidential unless there is risk to the young person or others
- ✓ Young people have the right to leave a program at any time.
- ✓ Covid vaccination certificates may be required at some point, to access youth programs

Duty of Care

Staff cannot provide care beyond basic supervision and support. A support worker must be provided if a young person has specific needs. Please speak to staff if you have any questions.

Accident/Injury

Staff do not administer medications or assist with medical issues. In the event of a serious injury, an ambulance may be called. Parent/guardian will be notified immediately and will be required to meet any expenses incurred.
