

## **MASTERPIECES 2K24 Art Competition and Exhibition 12-25 Years**

### **Masterpieces 2K24 conditions of entry**

Framing is optional for 2D artworks and will not influence judging.

Please consider how the artwork will be hung. 2D artworks MUST have either D-rings backing string or wire, or works on paper to have tape for pinning to wall etc.

One entry per person (which can be a diptych or triptych or installation etc.) If more than one entry is submitted, the curator will consider both works showing based on the total number of entries and works submitted to the competition.

Sale of artwork is encouraged but optional. Please specify on the entry form and include the price. The sale price must include 20% gallery commission.

Artists are residents of the City of Mandurah OR go to school OR work within the City. Artworks are to be no larger than 100cm x 100cm.

Artwork must have been created between 2023 and 2024 preferably outside of set school projects.

No copyrighted material is permissible including Fan Art and artworks deemed to include cultural appropriation. Any entries deemed inappropriate for the exhibition will be excluded.

The City of Mandurah will take all due care, however, holds no responsibility for damage or loss caused to works during installation, exhibition and de-installation.

Copyright remains the property of the artist. The City of Mandurah reserves the right to reproduce images of works for promotional, marketing or educational purposes for current and future exhibitions. This includes, but is not limited to exhibition catalogues, print media, social media, website, video footage, exhibition or archival purposes in any manner connected with the exhibition. The artist and photographer will be credited in all instances.

The judging panel's decision is final, and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

Judging is completed anonymously to avoid conflicts of interest.
