How you can help enjoy and preserve the unique coastal area at Tims Thicket and White Hill

Please follow these simple guidelines to assist us with the continued preservation of this beautiful place.

- 1. Access is permitted to the beaches only. Stay on the beach and use only the approved entry and exit areas (see map inside). Access to dunal areas is not permitted, this includes sandboarding.
- 2. Only 4WD vehicles that are licensed for the road are permitted to use the beach. No motorbikes, four wheelers or dune buggies.
- 3. Your gas cooker is welcome. No other fires are permitted. **No camping.**
- 4. Please remove all your litter. Take it home with you or deposit it in the bins provided on Tims Thicket and White Hill Roads (see map).
- 5. No vehicle access north of Tims Thicket Beach access point.
- 6. Beach access between Tims Thicket and White Hill may be inaccessible during high tide.
- 7. There is a back track NORTH of Seal Rock if needed (see map inside).

Remember, the future of this coastline is in your hands.

IMPORTANT

- DRIVE AT A SAFE SPEED at all times
- LOWER YOUR TYRE PRESSURE before entering the beach. This will reduce surface damage to the beach and tracks.
- There are TOILETS at Tims Thicket
- There are NO TOILETS at White Hill.
