## **Key Focus Area 1: Economic**

Project	Status as of 31/12/2023
Waterfront Redevelopment – (Western Foreshore, Eastern Foreshore South, Eastern	Planned Western Foreshore Redevelopment works have now been completed. Works related to commercial opportunities in progress.
Foreshore North, and Smart Street Mall Redevelopment)	All works in the Eastern Foreshore south section have been completed. The existing ablution block has been demolished, and new ablution construction has commenced. Reserve works surrounding the area is expected to commence in February 2024. The facility is expected to be complete by April.  Detailed design for Eastern Foreshore North Redevelopment is complete, works tender currently under review. Works are expected to commence after Crab Fest 2024.
	The primary scope of work for Smart Street Mall has been completed. Minor paving works are to commence in February 2024.
Peel Street Upgrade – (between Anstruther Road and Sutton Street)	Peel Street Upgrade works commenced in December, with major road closures expected to be from February to June. Works are expected to be completed by mid 2024.
Western Foreshore Commercial Site	Preferred proponent endorsed by Council in November 2022. Briefing on proposal held with Elected Members in December 2023.
	Ongoing discussions underway with the proponent to inform the draft Heads of Agreement which will set out the terms of any City contributions to the project. Report to be presented to Council in early 2024 for endorsement.
	Business Case being developed for DPLH leasing process and is due for completion by March 2024.
Yalgorup National Park Eco-tourism Development	The Concept Plan for the Yalgorup NP is being prepared by DBCA and was provided to the City for comment in December, with a Detailed Plan for priority project areas to follow.
	Feedback on the Concept Plan has been provided and it is expected that the Detailed Plan will be completed and presented to Council in April 2024.
	Following from the concept plan work and estimated costings, a request letter has been sent to local members seeking an increase in election commitment funding to deliver stage 1.
City Centre Master Plan and Parking Plan	City Centre Master Plan and Parking Plan were approved for advertising by Council in November 2023. The number of public submissions received to date is currently low with the advertising period to be extended to the end of February 2024. Implementation expected to begin in Q4 23/24.





Integrated Transport Strategy (ITS)	The Strategy was adopted by Council for advertising purposes in December 2023.
Aged Care Training Centre of Excellence	The Aged Care Training Centre of Excellence is a project resulting from the Transform Mandurah initiative. In August 2023, Faircloth McNair & Associates were nominated as the consultant to undertake a Needs Analysis and Feasibility Study into the concept.
	The Needs Analysis was completed by the consultants, and the Feasibility Study commenced in Q2 23/24. Additionally, both a co-design workshop and model design workshop were held together with participants from the aged care industry, support sector groups and training providers. The feasibility study is expected to be finalised and presented to Elected Members on the outcomes of the work, in Q3 23/24.

Arts and Culture Strategy	The City's new Arts and culture Strategy was endorsed by Council in August 2023, and planned outcomes are on target.

	Phase 1 engagement was undertaken in August 2023. Phase 2 is currently underway. A community workshop was held in December 2023 with approximately 50 community members. Data analysis and draft Plan development to commence in January 2024.

Economic	Estuary Bridge Expansion	Duplication of the Mandurah Estuary Bridge construction work is expected to commence in January 2024, be completed by late 2025.
Social	Common Ground facility	Construction is due to commence in 2024 and expected to open to tenants in 2026.
Social	Social Housing Development - Greenfields and Falcon	State Government funding has been approved for the development of social housing in Greenfields (\$5m) and Falcon (\$1.95m), through the Social Housing Economic Recovery Package (SHERP). The Greenfields development involves 35 one-, two- & three-bedroom apartments, while the Falcon development involves 8 two bedroom apartments.
		Builders have been involved and cost estimations are being prepared.
		Housing Choices are engaging with Department of Communities to obtain further funding support to meet cost escalations.
		The development application has been formally lodged and assessments are expected to commence in Q2 23/24.
Health	Peel Health Campus upgrade	WA State Government funding announced for a major redevelopment of the Peel Health Campus (\$152 million). A procurement process for an adjoining private hospital within the Peel Health Campus is underway. The City has now been engaged as a key stakeholder to provide input into the process. An announcement by Government regarding the transfer of the hospital to public management has delayed progress of development plans.
