Our comprehensive Incursion Education Program is aimed at Year 1 to Year 6 students over a one (1) incursion with a follow up quiz via the Kahoot application. We also provide additional programs focusing on best practice waste management in the schools, that may include the facilitation and setting up of composting, worm farms and waste wise collection points for waste streams such as soft plastics, textiles and CDS eligible containers.
