Part A

That Council:

1. Acknowledge the Strong Women's Group cultural obligations in protecting and advocating for Aboriginal heritage **and is committed to genuine, collaborative reconciliation with the Bindjareb community and we are committed to deepen our understanding of local Indigenous heritage and cultural knowledge.**
2. Affirm **the Chief Executive Officer has the power to determine any activities that are restricted or prohibited within a City building.** ~~support that a protest cannot take place within a City building.~~
3. Acknowledge that the actions taken are ~~consistent with~~**in** the CEO's statutory authority and the City's workplace safety obligations.

Comment: The amendment to resolution one, reinforces Councils commitment to engagement and reconciliation with the Binjareb community. Amendments to resolutions two and three ensure that Council are not resolving matters that are outside of the role of Council to deal with the management of the City's administration and operations.
