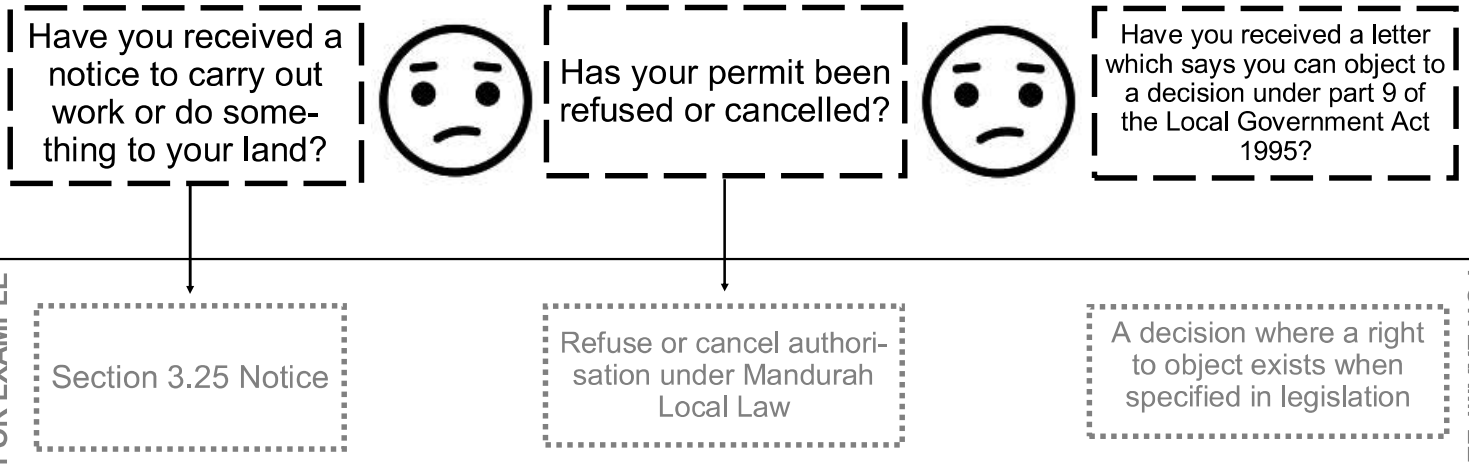


Objections and Review (Part 9) Local Government Act 1995



If you object to the decision you can apply to:

Within 28 days of the decision

Within 42 days of the decision

City of Mandurah

OR

State Administrative Tribunal

Submit **Form 4** to Chief Executive Officer via council@mandurah.wa.gov.au

The City not will review an objection if the objection has also been submitted to SAT

Council Outcome

- 1. Officer decision upheld; or
- 2. Decision varied; or
- 3. Decision revoked (with or without new decision)

If a decision is not made on your application within 35 days, you can wait for a decision to be made or apply directly to SAT

You may apply to SAT for review (**Strict timeframes apply**)

OR

You may accept and action the final decision
No further action

Contact SAT and apply for a review

Merits review of decision

SAT Outcome

- 1. Officer decision upheld; or
- 2. Decision varied; or
- 3. Decision revoked (with or without new decision)
